Day 1:

Angkor Thom and the World Famous Phare Circus.

Today we start with the small circuit of the Angkor Archeological Park. First, of course, we need to pick up your 3 day ticket at the government ticket office. They will take your photograph and provide you with your pass which you will need to wear while in the park, it also makes a cool souvenir!



From here we begin! Drive down the lush jungle enclosed road, with monkeys playing along the side, with cold water provided and proceed to the Angkor Thom South Gate. Bayon Temple, known as the smile of Angkor greets you with over 200 smiling carved faces. Then Baphuon Phimeanakas, the Elephant Terrace and Terrace of the Leper King. We also visit Ta Keo and the famous Ta Phrom temple, seen in the Anglie Joile movie "TombRaider". Watch the sun set, with golden rays over the ancient temples from Pre Rue Temple, then return to your accommodation and freshen up.

In the evening we go to enjoy the famous Phare Circus. More than a circus, Phare is uniquely Cambodian and daringly modern. Using theater, dance, music and modern arts, performers tell Cambodian stories, new and traditional. These performers come from the most difficult social and economic backgrounds and have bonded as their own "family". World renowned, this circus is the top



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rated attraction in Siem Reap outside on Angkor Wat. Please note, no animals are used in the circus. The performance begins at 8pm and runs for 1 hour. Dinner may be purchased at the on-site restaurant, or at your desired restaurant in town.

Day 2:

Cambodian Country Life & Tone Sap Lake

Visit the local Cambodian markets and learn about Cambodian foods from the qualified English speaking chef. We also enjoy an oxen cart ride into the local village through the rice paddies and past the jungles that almost vibrate with life. On arrival at a local house, under the guidance of your chef, prepare your Cambodian lunch, and then enjoy your creation!



After lunch we travel to Tone Sap, South East Asia's largest fresh water lake. The lakes size and volume vary significantly depending on the season. We will take a boat along the lake and see many of the floating villages and people who call these waters their home. Returning to the dock, we head back to your hotel where you can freshen up and then choose one of the many restaurants of international standard that Siem Reap has to offer.

Day 3:

Angkor Wat Sunrise and Grand Circuit



This morning we start early at 4.30am. We watch one of the world's most famous sunrises, over the temple of Angkor Wat. A serene and stunning start to your day. From there, in the cool of the morning, explore the world's largest religious monument, experience its glory and

wonder. Then we continue on, when you are ready, to the Grand Tour of Angkor. This includes Preah Khan, Neak Pean, Ta Som, East Mebon, Pre Rue, Banteay Kdei and Prasat Kravan. Then return to your accommodation to relax and enjoy Siem Reap nightlife.

Day 4:

Banteay Srei & Kulen National Park

Start north east of the main group of temples that once belonged to the medieval capitals of Yasodharapura and Angkor Thom. Banteay Srei is built from a pink sandstone, a medium that lends itself to the intricate and elaborate carvings that adorn it. Miniature in scale when compared to Angkor Wat and Angkor Thom, it is known as the jewel of Angkor and the Citadel of the Woman.

From there we visit the wondrous Kulen Nation Park.

Considered a holy mountain of Cambodia and of special religious significance, these waterfalls are a thunderous delight. Lunch at their base, and enjoy swimming in their crystal clear waters. Visit the temple of Preag Ang Temple, a 16th century monastery known for its giant reclining Buddha on top of the steepest cliff. Return in the late afternoon to Siem Reap.



Day 5:

Koh Ker & Bang Mealea



After breakfast at your hotel, our guide will collect you to start today's adventures. We visit Koh Ker and Beng Mealea Temples. Also known as the Lotus Pond Temples, these are often missed by many travelers and their age is undefined by archeologists and remain largely unrestored. They provide a unique look back in time. Then, with cold drinks in hand we return to Siem Reap, for your onwards travel or leisure in town.
